- 6.3 The Monitoring Committee members agreed that the potential applicants should be informed that the Open call for project proposals for standard projects for Priority 1 and 3 (SO6.2) and Open call for project proposals for standard projects for Priority 2 are closed and that a new Open call for project proposals for standard projects for Priority 1, 2 and 3 (SO 6.2) is expected to be published in the last quarter of 2024 and the first deadline for the submission of project proposals is expected in the first quarter of 2025.
- 6.4 The Monitoring Committee members agreed on the MA/JS proposals regarding administrative and eligibility criteria for the next Deadline of the Open Call for Priority 1, 2 and 3 (SO 6.2).
