# Accessibility statement

- Jems the electronic monitoring system is intended for the submission of projects to a public call and for reporting and monitoring of projects and programmes. Possible adaptations of the Jems online system would impose a disproportionate burden on MCRD and would significantly increase the risk of difficulties in ensuring the smooth functioning of the system.
