



Decisions of the 12th meeting of the Monitoring Committee of the Cooperation Programme Interreg V-A Slovenia-Croatia

(Online, 20 April 2022)

DECISION 1:

The Monitoring Committee members approved the agenda.

DECISION 2:

The Monitoring Committee members were informed about the current state of programme implementation and foreseen activities in the frame of the CP Interreg V-A SI-HR 2014-2020 and on programming of 2021-2027.

DECISION 3:

The Monitoring Committee members were informed and discussed about the FRISCO project results.

DECISIONS 4:

4.1 The Monitoring Committee members approved the changes of the CP SI-HR 2014-2020. 4.2 The Monitoring Committee members agreed that Managing Authority/Joint Secretariat could make smaller editorial changes to the CP SI-HR 2014-2020.

DECISIONS 5:

5.1 The Monitoring Committee members were informed about the received Applications and assessment process within the 3rd Deadline of the Open Call for Proposals.

5.2 The Monitoring Committee members decided to approve 3 projects in the frame of Priority axis 3 by reducing the budget of each project for 10 %. The approved projects are the following: MAX AID, CRO-SI-SAFE, IstraConnect.

5.3 The Monitoring Committee members approved the projects under the conditions stated in the Summary appraisal grids and gave a mandate to the Joint Secretariat to check the fulfilment of those minor conditions and any other clarifications needed with the Lead partners (in the frame of the face-to-face meetings).

5.4 The Monitoring Committee members decided not to postpone projects but to reject 3 projects since 4th Deadline of the Open Call is the last Deadline and postponement is not relevant anymore. Therefore, the Monitoring Committee members decided to reject 3 projects in the Frame of Priority axis 3. The rejected projects are the following: Ready2Respond, eTransNet, QuakeCo.

5.5 The Monitoring Committee members rejected 2 projects in the frame of Priority axis 3. The rejected projects are the following: Mobi4u, SPREMNI!.
